The purpose of the award is to recognize the adults who give countless hours of dedicated service as mentors and leaders to our Service Leadership Programs. This year I hope you will give serious consideration to nominate your Faculty Advisors and Kiwanis Advisors. These men and women get very little pay or recognition. The intended result of this effort is to strengthen the bond between local Kiwanis clubs, schools and your Service Leadership Programs, and contributing to the growth of the Texas-Oklahoma Foundation.

I urge you and your board of directors to consider applying for this award for a deserving individual serving your youth. Winners will be announced at the Service Leadership youth convention for Key Club and CKI. If your nominee is granted the award, I suggest you present it at the school during assembly so the principal and others are recognized for their contributions. I also suggest you find ways to involve dignitaries, past lieutenant governors, members of your local club, and district leaders in the presentation. This is an excellent way to publicize the activities your club is contributing towards the Service Leadership Programs.

The cost of this award is funded by the Past Lieutenant Governor's Association. The award consists of a certificate announcing a \$100 donation to the Texas-Oklahoma Foundation, in the name of the person recognized for distinguished and dedicated service to the sponsored program named, and an inscribed desk award (paper weight or obelisk).

You, the sponsoring Kiwanis Club, would be responsible to complete the Nomination Form nominating a worthy individual and to give appropriate recognition locally to the recipient. A minimum of fifteen awards are to be granted annually by the Past Lieutenant Governor's Association. This will total \$1,500 for a scholarship from the Texas-Oklahoma Foundation each year.
